

Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel is the UK's largest inter-school walking, wheeling, scooting and cycling challenge that inspires pupils to be amazing and take active journeys to school.

The 2022 challenge

See your local area from a new perspective, learn about the benefits of active travel and discover amazing journeys to school from around the world.

This year the challenge will run from 21 March–1 April. Register for the challenge from January 2022 at www.bigwalkandwheel.org.uk.

How it works

On each day of the challenge schools compete to see who can record the greatest number of pupils walking, using a wheelchair, scooting or cycling to school.

A school's best five days will determine their final position and schools at the top of their leaderboards will receive an exclusive Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel certificate.

Prizes

All schools will be entered into daily prize draws for rewards if over 15% of your school takes part on each day of the challenge. Prizes up for grabs include accessories and equipment to help your school travel actively.

Who can take part in the Big Walk and Wheel 2022?

All schools in the UK can take part in the Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel (provided they have a DfE or SEED no. or an IRN). All pupils can take part in Big Walk and Wheel 2022 by taking active journeys to school. Other ways of taking part exist for children with specific barriers to participation.

How do I register?

Simply fill in your school details on the **Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel registration page**.

What counts in the challenge?

For each pupil you can log one active journey to school per day – this includes walking, using a wheelchair, scooting and cycling.

For children with specific barriers to participation (special educational needs, disabilities, use of LA provided transport, remote learning, boarding school boarders) you can log one alternative activity instead. Please see the **Ways to take part in the challenge** pdf for further details.
